2	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council enacted Resolution No.

6	WHEREAS,	Section 1 (B) of the statute states that "the Office of the Attorney
7		General shall have overall responsibility for providing legal advice and
8		representation to all officials, agencies, departments, divisions, and
9		branches of the Nation's government, and for representing the Nation
10		in all legal proceedings"; and
11	WHEREAS,	there are significant areas of legal representation in the Judicial Branch
12		important to the effective operation of the Tribal Courts, such as
13		
14		pending cases, in which the Attorney General is ethically prevented
15		from giving the Branch legal advice; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary has proposed in their Fiscal Year 1992
17		budget the position of Court Solicitor who would be responsible for
18 19		giving legal advice to the Judicial Branch; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee, which is the oversight committee for
21		the Office of the Attorney General, held a joint meeting with the
22		Judiciary Committee, which is the oversight committee for the Judicial
23		
24		Branch; and
25	WHEREAS,	both committees recommend to the Legislative Council that approval
26		and funding of the position of Court Solicitor be conditioned on an
27		amendment to the statute creating the Office of the Attorney General,
