3 **WHEREAS,** *on the 25th day of September 1991, the Legislative Council adopted*  
4 *Resolution No. 91-421 approving the FY 92 Judicial Branch budget;*  
5 *and*

6 **WHEREAS,** *on or about the 25th day of September 1991, the Legislative Council*  
7 *determined that it would not entertain any new position requests for*  
8 *FY 92; and*

9  
10 **WHEREAS,** *the Legislative Council did provide those programs the opportunity to*  
11 *return to the Legislative Council pursuant to FY 92 budget*  
12 *modifications and resubmit those requests for new positions; and*

13 **WHEREAS,** *the Judicial Branch has requested to modify its FY 92 budget to*  
14 *include the positions of Solicitor and Intervention Resource Officer;*  
15 *and*

16  
17 **WHEREAS,** *the Legislative Judiciary and the Budget and Finance Committees did*  
18 *meet at a joint meeting on the 27th day of August 1991 to review*  
19 *and consider the FY 92 Judicial Branch budget which included the*  
20 *Solicitor and Intervention Resource Officer positions; and*

21 **WHEREAS,** *at the conclusion of this joint meeting it was decided to approve the*  
22 *FY 92 Judicial Branch budget inclusive of the aforementioned new*  
23 *positions.*

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that*  
26 *it does hereby approve the FY 92 Judicial Branch Modification No. 1.*



7 will increase in the amount of \$46,120.00 and are hereby  
8 appropriated from the FY 1992 General Revenues of the Nation to  
9 carry out the activities supported by this budget modification.


11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on

14 pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the  
15 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation  
16 on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
17 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
18 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






