9	WHEREAS,	by Legislative Council Resolution No. 349-88, the Tohono
10		O'Odham Nation did authorize the C.A.P. Link Pipeline east of
11		and parallel to Interstate 19 for delivery of water allocated by the
12		Nation to the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. farmlands;

15	WHEREAS,	in order to supply irrigation water to the San Xavier Cooperative
16		Farm lands, it is necessary to install a 24 inch pipeline on a
18		portion of the Nation's land located along the I-19 freeway; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Bureau of Reclamation has the need for and will file an
20		application for right-of-way through the property for this purpose;

23	WHEREAS,	a permanent right-of-way is necessary for the purpose of
25		installing a 24 inch underground pipeline, as part of the water
26		delivery system to the San Xavier Cooperative Association farms,
27		and effects eight tenths (0.8), plus or minus acres, of Tribal land

in the SW 1/4 Section 35, T15S, R13E, G&SRB&M, in the San

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Xavier District, Pima County, Arizona. A copy of the survey map of said right-of-way is attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and made a part hereof; and

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WHEREAS.

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WHEREAS. a temporary easement is also necessary for use during the period of construction of the water delivery system and effects eight tenths (0.8) plus or minus acres in the SW 1/4 section 35, T15S, R13E, G&SRB&M, in the San Xavier District, Pima County, Arizona. A copy of the survey map of said temporary easement is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit B, and made a part hereof. WHEREAS. an appraisal of the value of the tribal land to be utilized for temporary easement and permanent rights-of-way has been done

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Vice-Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized

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to negotiate and execute the grant of permanent rights-of-way and

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temporary easements, provided however, that any amendments

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affecting the funding or funding levels shall be submitted for

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further prior approval by this Council.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that

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the amount paid to the Nation by the Bureau of Reclamation, in

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the amount of \$6,480.00, for the tribal land portion be paid to the

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San Xavier District upon receipt by the Nation.

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the <u>6TH</u>. day of <u>JANUARY</u>, <u>1992</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,388.0</u> FOR; <u>336.0</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>02</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section <u>2 (d)</u>

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of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,

pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
