3 **WHEREAS, the Nation's gaming operation at Papago Bingo is an essential**
4 **source of revenue for the Nation; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the continued successful operation of Papago Bingo is of**
7 **paramount concern to the Nation; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Nation has been attempting to negotiate with the State of**
10 **Arizona since 1988 for a tribal-state compact pursuant to the**
11 **requirements of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C.**
12 **§2701 et seq. (the "Act"); and**

14 **WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has been reluctant to actively pursue compact**
15 **negotiations and has recently expressed opposition to any**
16 **discussion of compact terms which provide for the operation of**
17 **video gaming machines; and**

18
19 **WHEREAS, officials of the State of Arizona have made public statements in**
20 **the media and elsewhere in opposition to Indian gaming; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the United States Attorney for the District of Arizona has**
23 **threatened enforcement of federal laws against gaming on Indian**
24 **reservations in the absence of a concluded tribal-state compact**
25 **authorizing Class III gaming as that term is defined in the Act;**

WHEREAS, *to counter the negative attention Indian gaming and the Nation's gaming operation have recently received and to place before the citizens of the City of Tucson, in particular, and the State of Arizona, in general, it is important to publicly communicate the positive impact Papago Bingo has had on the Nation's ability to provide essential governmental services and programs to its people; and*

WHEREAS, *the marketing communications and public relations firm of Hanson, Moser & Associates of Phoenix, Arizona is able and prepared to assist the Nation's elected officials in accurately portraying the nature and purpose of the Nation's gaming operation and the benefits received from gaming revenues, through the preparation of press releases and/or news conferences and/or other avenues; and*

WHEREAS, *the Legislative Council Commerce Committee and the Nation's Compact Negotiating Committee have jointly recommended that the Nation enter into a consultant contract with Hanson, Moser & Associates.*

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Legislative Council that the
5 *Nation's Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate*
6 *and conclude a consultant contract with Hanson, Moser &*
7 *Associates of Phoenix, Arizona for the provision of public*
8 *relations and media consultation services, for a nine month period*
9 *commencing January 1, 1992 and ending September 30, 1992, to*
10 *accurately portray the Nation's gaming operation and the positive*
11 *impact the gaming revenues have had on the Nation, in an initial*
12 *amount not to exceed \$5,000, which amount may be increased by*
13 *Resolution of the Legislative Council.*

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the amount of \$5,000 is hereby
18 *appropriated from the Bingo Revenue Account, Account No.*
19 *920004 and transferred into Executive Office Account No.*
20 *01-1001-140 (Public Relations Account), to fund the consultant*
21 *contract with Hanson, Moser & Associates.*

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT** the public relations consultants, Hanson,
25 *Moser & Associates shall be supervised by and take direction from*
26 *the Nation's Compact Negotiating Committee, as reappointed*
