**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 92-018**

3 **WHEREAS,** *by Legislative Order No. 92-014, passed on January 9, 1992, the*  
4 *Tohono O'odham Legislative Council established January 14,*  
5 *1992 as the date for a Special Council Meeting to hear status*  
6 *reports concerning O'odham in Mexico issues and to address*  
7 *unfinished business; and*

10 **WHEREAS,** *during the agenda review for January 14, 1992, the Water*  
11 *Resources Committee introduced two items and suggested that the*  
12 *two items be addressed as items #1 and #2 before proceeding with*  
13 *the established agenda; and*

15 **WHEREAS,** *such recommendation was defeated by Legislative Order No. 92-*  
16 *017; and*

18 **WHEREAS,** *a motion was made to add the two items to the end of this day's*  
19 *agenda.*


20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** *that the Tohono O'odham Legislative*  
21 *Council hereby amends the agenda established for January 14,*  
22 *1992 to include as item (5) Water Code Consultant Contract with*  
23 *Fain Gildea; and as item (6) Water Project Office Interim Budget.*

27 *Council on the 14th day of January, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was*  
28 *present with a vote of 977.5 FOR; 286.5 AGAINST; 364.0 NOT VOTING; and*  
*114.0 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1*  
*(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by*


