3 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 92-035 the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
4 **Council certified the results of the Recall Election held in the**
5 **District of Gu Vo and seated Mr. Michael Flores to replace**
6 **Councilman Virgil Lewis as one of two primary representatives of**
7 **the Gu Vo District; and**

9 **WHEREAS, by Legislative Order No. 92-037, the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
10 **Council certified the election of Joanne Preston as the Legislative**
11 **Vice Chairwoman; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Councilwoman Preston's new position has left one vacancy on**
14 **each of the three following Committees: Natural Resources**
15 **Committee, the Health & Human Services Committee and the**
16 **Commerce Committee; and**

19 **WHEREAS, Councilman Michael Flores is eligible for appointment to three**
20 **Legislative Committees.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
22 **Council that it hereby appoints Councilman Michael Flores to the**
23 **Natural Resources Committee, the Health & Human Services**
24 **Committee and the Commerce Committee.**




