3 **WHEREAS, Public Law 100-485, the Family Support Act of 1988, was enacted**
4 **into law on October 13, 1988 to revise the AFDC Program to**
5 **emphasize work, child support, and family benefits, to amend**
6 **Title IV of the Social Security Act, to encourage and assist needy**
7 **children and parents under the program to obtain the education,**
8 **training and employment needed to void long term welfare**
9 **dependence; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council by means of Resolution**
13 **No. 91-464 provided interim funding for the first quarter of FY**
14 **1992 from General Revenues to maintain operation of the JOBS**
15 **Program due to no approved allocation from the Department of**
16 **Health and Human Services, Administration for Children &**
17 **Family; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has been informed of an award of**
21 **\$82,715.00 which is based on 50% of the total estimated**
22 **allocation for the first six months of Fiscal Year 1992; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Job Opportunities Basic Skills Program has submitted a**
25 **budget reflecting the award amount of \$82,715.00 for the period**
26 **of October 01, 1991 through March 31, 1992 for review and**

3 **WHEREAS, the funds which were appropriated in the amount of \$20,290.00**
4 **by Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 91-464**
5 **did stipulate that funds are to be reimbursed to the Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Accounting Office will prepare a Journal Voucher to**
8 **reimburse the Nation's General Account.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
10 **Council that it does hereby approve the FY 1992 Job**
11 **Opportunities Basic Skills Program Budget in the amount of**
12 **\$82,715.00 and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the**
13 **budget.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that**
17 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman,**
18 **Vice-Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized**
19 **to negotiate and execute the grant, provided, however, that any**
20 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant**
21 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
25 **Council on the 3RD. day of FEBRUARY, 1992 at a meeting at which a**
26 **quorum was present with a vote of 1,667.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 57.0 NOT**
27 **VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
