3 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'odham Nation adopted Res. No. 51-90 authorizing*
4 *the application for Community Development Block Grant funds*
5 *for specified projects; and*

7 **WHEREAS,** *Housing and Urban Development-Community Development Block*
8 *Grant awarded the Sil Nakya, and Sikol Himatke proposal for*
9 *funding; and*

10
11 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'odham Nation also adopted a priority listing*
12 *(Resolution No. 125-90), presented by Indian Health Services,*
13 *which was submitted to Environmental Protection Agency for*
14 *funding consideration under the 1990 Indian Set aside Grant*
15 *Program; and*

18 **WHEREAS,** *Environmental Protection Agency notified the Nation that they*
19 *have identified the Sil Nakya project to receive grant funds, under*
20 *the Indian Set-Aside Program, for construction of a wastewater*
21 *collection and treatment facility for the Sil Nakya Community in*
22 *the Schuk Toak district; and*

25 **WHEREAS,** *Environmental Protection Agency funds in the amount of*
26 *\$416,000.00 has been set aside for the Sil Nakya project and*
27 *\$40,000.00 is made available for planning and preliminary*

3 **WHEREAS, the funded Sil Nakya project under the CDBG program, consists**
4 **of, construction of two new wells, within a mile radius of the**
5 **community, including a wastewater collection and treatment**
6 **system; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the proposed well site recommended by USGS, proved to be**
10 **unfeasible, Option number two is recommended, construction of**
11 **a water transmission line connecting the existing Santa Rosa**
12 **Ranch water system, to the Sil Nakya Community; and**

14 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation, Schuk Toak District, and**
15 **the Sil Nakya Community to amend the Sil Nakya project scope**
16 **of work to implement Alternative number one.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Community Development**
19 **Block Grant, for Schuk Toak District, Sil Nakya Community**
20 **project for well construction/wastewater collection and treatment**
21 **and bathroom additions be amended by deleting wastewater**
22 **collection and treatment and transfer the funds to cover for the**
23 **additional costs in the Transmission line and other categories as**
24 **identified in the attached budget.**

amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant
shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 5TH. day of FEBRUARY, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) &(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






