3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Family**
4 **Preservation Project under the Title II of the Indian Child**
5 **Welfare Act (ICWA); and**

7 **WHEREAS, such Social Service operations have been successful and**
8 **beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Social Service Department has the primary**
11 **responsibility to provide for the care, treatment and welfare of**
12 **children found to be in need of such care; and**

13
14 **WHEREAS, the incidence of child abuse and neglect in the Tohono O'odham**
15 **Nation is high and increasing and family intervention and**
16 **prevention services are limited; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Social Service Department has developed**
19 **and administered a home based, intensive family service program**
20 **which focuses on preventing family breakups and reunification of**
21 **families; and**

23 **WHEREAS, there is a continued need for a program which preserves the**
24 **family through service provision; and**

26 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, Social Service is eligible to apply**
27 **for special Congressional Appropriations for departmental**
28 **activities.**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is in support of the request of the Tohono O'odham Social Service Department as herein stated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Tohono O'odham Appropriations Committee to bring this request in the amount of \$201,403., to the appropriate members and committees of Congress.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 18TH. day of FEBRUARY, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




