Contract with HMA by \$7,500 in order to permit HMA to continue offering advice and services pursuant to the terms of the Consultant contract; and the services provided by HMA benefit all parties to the

WHEREAS, the services provided by HMA benefit all parties to the Management Agreement between the Nation and the Manager of Papago Bingo and are reasonable operating costs of the gaming operation within the meaning of Section 7.1.A of the Management Agreement; and

WHEREAS, to maximize the resources available to the Nation, it is in the best interests of the Nation to bill Papago Bingo for the services rendered to the Nation by HMA to date as well as for future services.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the increase in the amount available in the Consultant Contract with Hanson, Moser & Associates by \$7,500 pursuant to Amendment No. 1, a copy of which is attached hereto.
- 2. The professional services rendered to the Nation by HMA shall be an operating cost of Papago Bingo and the Nation shall bill

Papago Bingo for the professional services rendered by HMA from January 1, 1992 to date, and all future services rendered pursuant to the Consultant Contract with HMA shall be billed to Papago Bingo as operating costs.

3. The amounts paid by Papago Bingo which reimburse the Nation for amounts the Nation has already paid to HMA for services rendered shall be reimbursed and credited to the Tribal Budget or Revenue Account from which those amounts were paid.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 12TH. day of MARCH, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,388.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 336.0 [8] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
