RESOLUTION NO. 92-100

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3 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department has the primary*
4 *responsibility to provide prevention and intervention services to*
5 *families at risk for child abuse and neglect; and*

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7 **WHEREAS,** *the Arizona Department of Economic Security provides funds for*
8 *the development and administration of child abuse and neglect*
9 *prevention programs under specified terms and conditions; and*

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11 **WHEREAS,** *Community Education and Information Program has been*
12 *identified as one means of preventing child abuse and neglect;*

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15 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department has submitted an*
16 *FY 1993 proposal for Community Education and Information*
17 *Services for review and approval.*

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19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative*
20 *Council that it does hereby approve the application of the Tohono*
21 *O'Odham Social Service Department for a contract to focus on*
22 *decreasing the incidence of child abuse and neglect through the*
23 *provision of Community Education and Information Services*
24 *reservation wide.*
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

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4 **July 01, 1992 and end on June 30, 1993.**

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
6 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the
7 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby
8 authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided
9 however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding
10 levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval
11 by this Council.

17 *was present with a vote of 1,617.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING;*
18 *and 107.0 [7] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section*
19 *1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted*
20 *by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the*
21 *Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,*
22 *1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).*
