7 **WHEREAS, such services for the youth have been successful and beneficial;**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to enter into an**
11 **agreement for services during FY 1993; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services/Prevention Education has**
13 **submitted a budget for review and approval by the Tohono**
14 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
17 **Council that it does support and authorize the Tohono O'odham**
18 **Nation to enter into an agreement with United Way of Tucson for**
19 **Prevention Education Services.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the Agreement will be**
23 **from July 01, 1992 through June 30, 1993.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
25 **that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the**
26 **Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby**
27 **authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement, provided**



11 *of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the*
12 *Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting*
13 *Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,*
14 *pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).*






