- WHEREAS, Twelve (12) O'Odham women have entered treatment at Pascua Alcoholism Treatment Home; eight (8) of these women have completed treatment and are in their recovery; and
- WHEREAS, the Behavioral Health Division has begun to discuss contracting with the

 Pascua Alcoholism Treatment Home for treatment of O'Odham women

 whose life is impaired due to alcohol or other drugs.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation supports the Behavioral Health Division efforts to contract with the Pascua Alcoholism Treatment Home.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation gives their utmost attention and expediency in finalizing a contract with the Pascua Alcoholism Treatment Home.
