- WHEREAS, this project requires reviewing case records from hospitals, substance abuse treatment programs, law enforcement facilities, medical examiner, and other relevant agencies; and
- WHEREAS, the site chosen for the test area is Pima County and southern Pinal and

  Maricopa Counties, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is located in the study area; and
- WHEREAS, the information from this surveillance study will assist the Tohono

  O'Odham Nation in planning prevention and treatment services; and
- WHEREAS, the information from this surveillance study may be used by the Tohono

  O'Odham Nation to obtain future funding for prevention and treatment services.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
