WHEREAS,	by Resolution 92-089, the Legislative Council established the						
	parameters for negotiating a final resolution of the Tohono						
	O'odham Nation's water rights under the Southern Arizona Water						
	Rights Settlement Act of 1982 ("SAWRSA") and the related law						
	suit entitled U.S. v. Tucson: and						

WHEREAS, representatives of the Nation have engaged in extensive settlement negotiations in meetings with representatives of the United States, City of Tucson, and San Xavier allottees, in which officials of Schuk Toak District, San Xavier District and the Cooperative Farm Association were invited to participate; and

WHEREAS, with the exception of the allottee representatives, the parties' negotiating representatives agreed to certain principles of settlement ("Settlement Principles") which, among other things, (1) acknowledge the Nation's rights to manage and control the SAWRSA water entitlements, subject only to limitations prescribed in SAWRSA, as it may be amended, and (2) delete final dismissal of <u>U.S. v. Tucson</u> as a condition which now applies under SAWRSA to certain of the United States' obligations owed to the Nation; and

provided that approval of the Legislative Council of the final Amendment package shall be required prior to introduction of the Amendments in Congress.

The Water Resources Committee, Chairman of the Nation, 2. and Attorney General are authorized and directed to meet with appropriate officials in the Department of Interior to communicate this action of the Legislative Council and to take all necessary and reasonable steps to secure final Amendments substantially in the form attached hereto which protect and enhance the Nation's water resources and the Nation's governmental authority over such resources.

The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 15TH day of April, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 614.5 FOR; 943.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.0 [06] ABSENT, failed to pass because it did not receive a majority of the votes cast, as required by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.
