

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(FY 1992 Water Projects Office Funding Request**  
**04/01/92 to 09/30/92)**

**RES. NO. 92-158**

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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Water Projects**  
4 **Office to provide administrative services under a P.L. 93-638**  
5 **contract with the Bureau of Reclamation for the development of**  
6 **projects in the Schuk Toak and San Xavier Districts through**  
7 **Contract No. 8-CS-32-00380 and Contract No. 8-CS-30-04830; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by means of Resolutions**  
11 **91-284 and 91-285 authorized one year extensions of the above**  
12 **mentioned contracts and approved budgets for FY 1992 to enable**  
13 **the continued operation of the Water Projects Office through the**  
14 **P.L. 93-638 Contracts; and**

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17 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by means of Resolution**  
18 **91-488 provided interim funding for the first and second quarters**  
19 **of FY 1992 from FY 1992 General Revenues to maintain operation**  
20 **of the Water Projects Office when the Bureau of Reclamation did**  
21 **not execute the one year extensions and budgets; and**

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23 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation has not provided requested contract**  
24 **extensions to the Tohono O'odham Nation in a manner consistent**  
25 **with the statutory requirements of Section 102 of P.L. 93-638, as**  
26 **amended and the decisions by the Bureau of Reclamation**

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*regarding the contract extensions are now being appealed through the Department of Interior; and*

**WHEREAS,** *the Water Projects Office has submitted a budget for staff salaries, support costs and subcontracts to be approved in the interim while the contracts are negotiated with the Bureau of Reclamation; and*

**WHEREAS,** *as a result of recent meetings with officials of the Bureau of Reclamation, the Executive Office and Water Projects Office, there has been progress towards negotiating new contracts for the continued operation of the Water Projects Office and contracting for development of the Farms; and*

**WHEREAS,** *the Water Projects Office is requesting from the Tohono O'odham Nation interim funding in the amount of \$305,592. to enable the operations of the office to continue for third and fourth quarters (4/01/92 to 9/30/92) or until either the requested contract modifications or a new contract is provided to the Tohono O'odham Nation. Reimbursement for those costs attributable to the contract, will be sought through the Bureau of Reclamation once the contract extensions are executed.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the funding request and*


authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that funds in the amount of \$305,592. are hereby approved from the SAWRSA Trust fund.


**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that reimbursement for such funds advanced by the Tohono O'odham Nation that are determined to be allocable to the contracts will be sought through the Bureau of Reclamation.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 15TH day of April, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,431.0 FOR; 127.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




