4 **Rights Office since 1978 and has successfully met the needs and**  
5 **rights of the O'Odham people; and**

6 **WHEREAS, funding for the Tribal Employment Rights Office has been**  
7 **supplemented by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission;**  
8 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding levels of the contract shall**  
11 **be submitted for review and approval; and**

12 **WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval by the**  
13 **Tribal Employment Rights Office.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**  
16 **Council that it hereby approves the amendment for the Equal**  
17 **Employment Opportunity Commission submitted by the Tribal**  
18 **Employment Rights Office and authorizes expenditures in**  
19 **accordance to the attached budget.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that**  
22 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman,**  
23 **Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized**  
24 **to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any**  
25 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the**  
26 **contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this**  
27 **Council.**


