3 **WHEREAS,** *a request was submitted by the Judiciary Committee of the*
4 *Tohono O'odham Legislative Council to approve an amendment*
5 *to the Law & Order Code entitled, "Title III - Civil Actions"; and*

7 **WHEREAS,** *this issue was considered by the full Council in some detail; and*

8 **WHEREAS,** *several concerns and questions were raised during the Council's*
9 *discussion of this matter; and*

10 **WHEREAS,** *the proposed Title III - Civil Actions will apply to all O'odham of*
11 *the Nation.*

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** *by the Tohono O'odham Legislative*
14 *Council that the proposed "Title III - Civil Actions" amendment*
15 *to the Law & Order Codes be presented to all Districts of the*
16 *Nation for input and comment, by the Legislative Representatives.*

18 **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED** *that further consideration of the full Council on*
19 *this matter will be in sixty (60) days.*

21 **BE IT FINALLY ORDERED** *that the Legislative committees with oversight will*
22 *meet with the Districts to present and discuss this proposal, if said*
23 *Districts request this to be done.*

24 *The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on*
25 *the 6TH day of May, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with*
26 *a vote of 1,273.5 FOR; 269.0 AGAINST; 62.5 NOT VOTING; and 119.0 [05]*
27 *ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(a) of*
28 *Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the*
Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting


