3 **WHEREAS,** *by memo dated May 6, 1992, the Budget & Finance Committee*  
4 *Chairman did request the dates of May 19 & 20, 1992 as special*  
5 *sessions to address the 1993 Grants & Contracts Proposals; and*



10 **WHEREAS,** *it is imperative that the Legislative Council address these*

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** *that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative*  
13 *Council hereby sets May 19 & 20, 1992 as Special Sessions*  
14 *requested by the Budget & Finance Committee to address the 1993*  
15 *Grants & Contracts Proposals.*

18 *The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative*  
19 *Council on the 7TH. day of MAY, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was*  
20 *present with a vote of 1,660.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 63.5 NOT VOTING; and*  
21 *-0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of*  
22 *Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the*  
23 *Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting*  
*Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,*  
*pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).*
