**(Rescinding Legislative Order No. 92-182)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 92-206**

2 **WHEREAS, Legislative Order No. 92-182 was enacted to set Special Council**  
3 **Sessions to review FY 1993 grants and contracts budgets; and**  
4

5 **WHEREAS, the dates set for the Special Sessions of May 19 and 20, 1992**  
6 **coincide with certain special activities as a direct result of the**  
7 **actions of the United States of America on May 12, 1992; and**


8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council wishes to support these**  
9 **activities to show unity and respect for all Arizona tribes.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**  
12 **that Legislative Order No. 92-182 setting May 19 and 20, 1992 as**  
13 **Special Sessions for review of FY 1993 grants and contracts**  
14 **budgets is hereby rescinded.**

15  
16 **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the FY 1993 grants and contracts budgets will**  
17 **be addressed and considered at the June General Session of the**  
18 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

19 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on**  
20 **the 18TH day of May, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with**  
21 **a vote of 1,269.5 FOR; 79.0 AGAINST; 375.5 NOT VOTING; and -0-**  
22 **ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(a) of**  
23 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
24 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
**Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,**  
**pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
