BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council. The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 2ND day of June, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 FOR; _-0- AGAINST; _-0- NOT VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of
