BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed contract has been approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, unless the agency authorizes and approves pre-award costs consistent with the Indian Self-Determination Act as amended and relevant contract regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman,
Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized
to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any
amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the
contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the <u>3RD</u> day of <u>June</u>, <u>1992</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,581.5</u> FOR; <u>142.5</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>02</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section <u>1 (f)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
