3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did complete their**  
4 **agenda items established for the June 3, 1992 General Session;**

7 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Chairwoman informed Council that the Nation's**  
8 **Compact Negotiating Committee will be meeting with Governor**  
9 **Fife Symington on the gaming activities, tomorrow, June 04,**  
10 **1992; and**

12 **WHEREAS, it is important that the Legislative Council be kept informed of the**  
13 **gaming activities affecting the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and**



16 **activities and its compacts.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
18 **Council that it hereby amend the agenda for the June 03, 1992**  
19 **General Session to include as item #9 a status report on all the**  
20 **gaming & compact activities.**

24 **day of JUNE, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote**  
25 **of 1,479.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 245.0 NOT VOTING; and 01 ABSENT,**  
26 **pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of**  
27 **the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
28 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
**Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
**Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
