3 **WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in 1982,**  
4 **replacing the Comprehensive Employment Training Act (CETA);**  
5 **and**

6 **WHEREAS, funding is made available to state and tribal governments to**  
7 **establish programs for improving the employment prospects of**  
8 **eligible persons through the designation of service delivery areas;**  
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is entitled to JTPA funds to develop a**  
11 **network of employment training programs throughout the State;**  
12 **and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Indian Reservations in Arizona have been designated as**  
14 **service delivery areas and are eligible to receive State JTPA**  
15 **funds; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is required to submit a Job Training**  
17 **Plan (JTP) for Fiscal Year 1993 and Fiscal Year 1994 for review**  
18 **and approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**  
20 **Council that it hereby approves the two (2) year Job Training**  
21 **Plan (JTP) for the Tohono O'Odham Nation for Fiscal Year 1993**  
22 **and Fiscal Year 1994 for the delivery of JTPA services on the**  
23 **Tohono O'Odham Reservation.**



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that  
the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the  
program in the interim while negotiations are still being  
conducted and no executed contract has been awarded by the  
Department of Economic Security.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that  
the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman,  
Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized  
to negotiate and execute the Job Training Plan, provided  
however, that any amendments affecting the delivery of JTPA  
Services on the Tohono O'Odham Nation shall be submitted for  
further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
Council on the 4TH day of June, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
present with a vote of 1,558.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and  
166.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section  
1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted  
by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the  
Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
