1 RESOLUTION NO. 92-249 2 WHEREAS. the Tohono O'Odham Election Board has received Petition No. 01-92-C 3 from concerned members of Chukut Kuk District to recall District 4 5 Chairman, Cecil Williams; and 6 WHEREAS, the Election Board submitted the Certification of the Recall Petition to 7 the Legislative Council Secretary on June 25, 1992; and 8 WHEREAS, the Election Ordinance of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, by Section 13, 9 10 Article X, cites the responsibility of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative 11 Council to establish a Special Recall Election dated within 40 days. 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative 13 Council has hereby established July 25, 1992 to conduct the Special 14 15 Recall Election in Chukut Kuk District of Cecil Williams. 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Election Board will be 17 responsible to conduct the Special Recall Election. 18 19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 6TH. day of JULY, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.585.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 138.5 NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant 21 to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (g) & (l) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 25 TOHONO, O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 26
