3 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Judicial*
4 *Services Program under FY 1992 P. L. 93-638 contract with the*
5 *Bureau of Indian Affairs; and*

6 **WHEREAS,** *any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract*
7 *shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham*
8 *Legislative Council; and*

10 **WHEREAS,** *an amendment has been submitted for review and approval reflecting*
11 *FY 1991 carryover funds by the Judicial Services Program.*

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative*
13 *Council does hereby approve the amendment to the Judicial Services*
14 *Program contract and requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to*
15 *carryover unexpended funds from FY 91 into FY 92 and authorizes*
16 *expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.*

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the*
20 *Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice*
21 *Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to*
22 *negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any*
23 *amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract*
24 *shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.*

of 1.641.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 83.0 NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant






