(Inter-Agency Agreement Between Indian Health Service/  
Sells Service Unit and Tohono O'odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 92-267**

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3 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'odham Health Department does provide preventive health*  
4 *care for Women, Infants, and children; and*

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6 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'odham Health Department, Community Health Services*  
7 *Branch and the Indian Health Service, Sells Service Unit, to meet U.S.*  
8 *Department of Agriculture requirements under 7CFR Part 246.4*  
9 *(a)(iii)(8) for the operation of the Special Supplemental Food Program*  
10 *for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program, will be by joint*  
11 *agreement operate the WIC Program on the Tohono O'odham*  
12 *Reservation in cooperation with the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona,*  
13 *Inc.; and*

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16 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'odham Community Health Services Branch-WIC Section*  
17 *and the Indian Health Services/Sells Service Unit agree to meet*  
18 *program responsibilities as designated; and*

19 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono o'odham Community Health Services Branch-WIC Section*  
20 *agrees to coordinate WIC services with delivery of other health services,*  
21 *determine program eligibility of applicants at initial and subsequent*  
22 *certification, provide nutrition education to Program participants and/or*  
23 *parents and guardians and implement the food delivery system of the*  
24 *Program; and*

27 **WHEREAS,** *the Indian Health Service/Sells Service Unit agrees to coordinate with*  
28 *WIC services, access and/or provide child health information upon*

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request, and provide therapeutic diet counseling for WIC referrals as indicated; and


**WHEREAS, the WIC Program has submitted for review the Inter-Agency Agreement between the Indian Health Service and Tohono O'odham Nation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono o'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Indian Health Service.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham LegislatiVe Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement, provided however, that any amendments affecting the agreement shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 9TH day of JULY, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,660.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 63.5 NOT VOTING; and 08 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
