

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Schuk Toak/San Xavier Predesign/Design - Contract No.**  
**8-CS-32-00380 Budget Modification No. 11)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 92-270**

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3 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated the Water Projects Office*  
4 *to provide administrative services under a P.L. 93-638 contract with the*  
5 *Bureau of Reclamation for the development of projects in the Schuk*  
6 *Toak District through Contract No. 8-CS-32-00380; and*

7  
8 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council authorized a one year*  
9 *extension of the contract and approved budget proposals for FY 1992*  
10 *to enable the continued operation of the Water Projects Office through*  
11 *the P.L. 93-638 Contracts; and*

12  
13 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council provided interim funding for*  
14 *FY 1992 from FY 1992 General Revenues and the SAWRSA Trust*  
15 *Fund to maintain operation of the Water Projects Office when the*  
16 *Bureau of Reclamation did not execute the one year extensions and*  
17 *budgets; and*

19 **WHEREAS,** *the Bureau of Reclamation has not provided requested contract*  
20 *extensions to the Tohono O'Odham Nation in a manner consistent with*  
21 *the statutory requirements of Section 102 of P.L. 93-638, as amended,*  
22 *and the decisions by the Bureau of Reclamation regarding the contract*  
23 *extensions are now being appealed through the Department of Interior;*

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27 **WHEREAS,** *the Water Projects Office has submitted a budget proposal for FY 1993*  
28 *for an additional one year extension of the contract which includes*

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

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
**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Nation Legislative Council that  
the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and, after conferring with the Water Resources Committee, execute a contract with the Bureau of Reclamation using the proposals which were reviewed and approved, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 9TH day of JULY, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,487.0 FOR; 57.0 AGAINST; 180.0 NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


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


