

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Water Projects Office Administrative Proposal FY 1993)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 92-271**

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3 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated the Water Projects Office to*  
4 *provide administrative services under P.L. 93-638 contracts with the*  
5 *Bureau of Reclamation for the development of farm projects in the*  
6 *Schuk Toak and San Xavier Districts; and*

7  
8 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council authorized a one year*  
9 *extension of the above mentioned contracts and approved budget*  
10 *proposals for FY 1992 to enable the continued operation of the Water*  
11 *Projects Office through the P.L. 93-638 Contracts.*

12  
13 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council provided interim funding for*  
14 *FY 1992 from FY 1992 General Revenues and the SAWRSA Trust Fund*  
15 *to maintain operation of the Water Projects Office when the Bureau of*  
16 *Reclamation did not execute the one year extensions and budgets; and*

17  
18 **WHEREAS,** *the Bureau of Reclamation has not provided requested contract*  
19 *extensions to the Tohono O'Odham Nation in a manner consistent with*  
20 *the statutory requirements of Section 102 of P.L. 93-638, as amended,*  
21 *and the decisions by the Bureau of Reclamation regarding the contract*  
22 *extensions are now being appealed through the Department of Interior;*

24 *and*

25 **WHEREAS,** *the Water Projects Office has submitted to the Tohono O'Odham*  
26 *Legislative Council a funding proposal for FY 1993 and a proposed*  
27 *application for a new three year contract under P.L. 93-638, as*  
28 *amended. The proposal includes staff salaries, support costs and*

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*subcontracts leading to completion of the design of the Schuk Toak Farm and San Xavier Cooperative Farm Rehabilitation; and*

**WHEREAS,** *the Water Projects Office has also submitted proposals for staff salaries, support costs and subcontracts for the San Xavier Cooperative Farm Rehabilitation Contract (No. 8CS-30-04830 - Modification No. 21) and for the Schuk Toak/San Xavier Predesign/Design Contract (No. 8-CS-32-00380 - Modification No. 11) to cover an additional one year extension of the contracts.*

**WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Nation wishes to continue its efforts towards the design of the Schuk Toak Farm, the San Xavier Cooperative Farm Rehabilitation and the implementation of SAWRSA, and to this end the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did review and approve the Implementation Plan, by Resolution No. 91-537, which was submitted by the Water Projects Office.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the contract proposal for \$3,788,503.00 for FY 1993 and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.*

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** *that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the Water Projects Office, the Executive Office and other departments to continue to proceed with execution of those activities outlined in the Implementation Plan.*

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
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
**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Nation Legislative Council that  
  
the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and, after conferring with the Water Resources Committee, execute a contract with the Bureau of Reclamation using the proposals which were reviewed and approved, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 9TH day of JULY, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,269.5 FOR; 57.0 AGAINST; 397.5 NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

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

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


