

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting Supplemental Federal Funding of \$150,000 for P.L. 93-638
Contract on Chuichu Water Inventory Program and
Approving Modification to Contract and Subcontract
to Increase Funding Level and Extend Term)

RESOLUTION NO. 92-273

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5 **WHEREAS,** *pursuant to Resolution 91-364, a P.L. 93-638 Contract in the amount*
6 *of \$250,000 (the "Contract") was executed by the Chairman on behalf*
7 *of the Tohono O'odham Nation for the purposes of conducting*
8 *technical work on the Sif Oidak water claims; and*

10 **WHEREAS,** *the initial term of the Contract was for the period from August 30,*
11 *1991 through March 31, 1992, and was thereafter extended to*
12 *September 30, 1992 pursuant to Modification No. 1; and*

13 **WHEREAS,** *pursuant to Resolution 91-364, a Subcontract was entered into with*
14 *Natural Resources Consulting Engineers ("NRCE"), as amended by*
15 *Amendment No. 1, to perform the technical studies prescribed in the*
16 *Contract; and*

18 **WHEREAS,** *the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") has notified the Nation that an*
19 *additional \$150,000 has been awarded to the Nation to carry out the*
20 *technical studies under the Contract; and*

21
22 **WHEREAS,** *upon receipt of an appropriate modification, the BIA has informed the*
23 *Nation that the original and supplemental awards can be combined and*
24 *incorporated in a single contract with a term ending March 31, 1994;*
25 *and*

27 **WHEREAS,** *the supplemental funding will enable NRCE to refine the technical*
28 *studies by upgrading the relevant data through additional field work*

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and other activities; and

WHEREAS, *the Budget & Finance and Water Resources Committees recommend
that the Legislative Council accept the supplemental funding, and
authorize modifications to the Contract and NRCE Subcontract to
include the additional funds and extend the terms of each to March 31,
1994.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The award of \$150,000 in supplemental funding for the
P.L. 93-638 Contract on the Chuichu Water Inventory Program is
hereby accepted.*
- 2. The Chairman of the Nation and Water Resources Committee, in
consultation with the Attorney General and the Office of Grants and
Contracts, are authorized to (a) negotiate and execute Modification
No. 2 to the Contract and Amendment No. 2 to the NRCE
Subcontract which incorporate the supplemental funding and extend
the term of each to March 31, 1994 and (b) execute such further
modifications to the Contract and Subcontract as may be
appropriate, provided that any such revision shall not change the
amount of funding or scope of work.*


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
The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 9TH day of JULY, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,495.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 229.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




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
