4 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the JTPA Title*
5 *II-B Summer Youth Employment Training Program under an FY*
6 *1992 grant with the United States Department of Labor; and*

7 **WHEREAS,** *the Nation has been informed of additional funds in the amount*
8 *of \$71,424.00 as a result of emergency legislation for the*
9 *expansion of the operation for the Calendar Year 1992 Summer*
10 *Program for Title II-B; and*

12 **WHEREAS,** *the budget amendment also reflects FY 1991 carry-over funds in*
13 *the amount of \$24,990.00; and*

14
15 **WHEREAS,** *any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the*
16 *grant shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono*
17 *O'odham Legislative Council; and*

19 **WHEREAS,** *an amendment has been submitted for review and approval by the*
20 *JTPA Title II-B Summer Youth Employment Training Program.*

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *that the Tohono O'odham Legislative*
22 *Council does hereby approve the amendment to the JTPA Title*
23 *II-B Summer Youth Employment Training Program and*
24 *authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.*

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that*
27 *the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman,*
28 *Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized*

5 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.


6 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative

Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






