3 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated the Water Resources Study*  
4 *Program under a P. L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian*  
5 *Affairs; and*

6  
7 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Nation has submitted a proposed recontract*  
8 *application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for services during fiscal*  
9 *year 1992; and*

10  
11 **WHEREAS,** *the Executive Office has negotiated with the Bureau of Indian Affairs*  
12 *on funding appropriation status for the Water Resources Study*  
13 *Program; and*

14 **WHEREAS,** *the amount of \$200,000.00 has been identified by the Bureau of Indian*  
15 *Affairs, Central Office to contract with the Nation; and*

16  
17 **WHEREAS,** *the Water Resources Study Program has submitted for review and*  
18 *approval a Budget Request for Tribal Funds in the amount of*  
19 *\$131,000.00 in the interim while contract negotiations are taking place.*

20  
21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council*  
22 *that it does hereby approve the funding request and authorizes*  
23 *expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.*

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** *that funds in the amount of \$131,000.00 are hereby*  
25 *approved from the FY 1992 General Revenues of the Nation.*

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** *that reimbursement for such funds advanced by the*  
28 *Tohono O'Odham Nation will be sought through the Bureau of Indian*

*The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 16TH day of JULY, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,546.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 63.5 NOT VOTING; and 114.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).*


