



**The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 3RD. day of AUGUST, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,265.0 FOR; 155.0 AGAINST; 83.0 NOT VOTING; and 221.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
