6 **Adoption into the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and**



21 **Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono**
22 **O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,**
23 **1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
24 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,**
25 **1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
