16 *Council that the adoption of the applicants from the Chukut Kuk*
17 *and Pisinemo Districts is hereby tabled pending further research*

20 **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED** *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that*
21 *this item will be brought back to Council for their consideration*
22 *during the September General Session.*




