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3 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council approved Resolution No. 04-32-89**  
4 **for Phase I of the San Lucy District Rehabilitation Project in the**  
5 **amount to \$779,237.00; and**

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7 **WHEREAS, Phase I of the San Lucy District Rehabilitation Project was**  
8 **completed on or about 03-14-91; and**

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10 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council approved Resolution No. 06-20-91**  
11 **for Phase II Rehabilitation in the amount of \$1,330,615.13; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has determined that installation of**  
13 **upducts and security screen doors on the 25 homes completed in**  
14 **the Phase I Rehabilitation Project will reduce utility costs,**  
15 **increase security and improve overall dwelling efficiency; and**

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17 **WHEREAS, the estimated material and installation costs for said upducts is**  
18 **\$6,407.00, and the estimated material and installation costs for**  
19 **said screen doors is \$8,000.; and**

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**WHEREAS, on July 30, 1992 the Budget & Finance Committee of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council reviewed and approved said budget modification.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council approves the Phase II Rehabilitation Project budget modification in the amount of \$14,407.00 to install upducts and security screen doors in the 25 homes completed in Phase I.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 10TH. day of AUGUST, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,660.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 63.5 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


**(Approving Phase II Rehabilitation Project Budget Modification)**


