10 **a certificate of Election Results from this Recall Election; and**

11 **WHEREAS, a Contest of Election Results was filed with the Election Board**
12 **alleging misconduct on the part of the Board which was**
13 **subsequently submitted to the Secretary of the Tohono O'Odham**
14 **Legislative Council in accordance with Article VIII of the**
15 **Uniform Election Ordinance; and**

19 **Council has ordered that the hearing on the Election Contest will**
20 **be held August 17, 1992; and**




The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day of August, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,421.5 FOR; 223.5 AGAINST; 79.0 NOT VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
