

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL**  
**(Establishing Rules of Procedure for Election Contest Hearing)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 92-321**

3 **WHEREAS, a contest to the Recall Election held on July 25, 1992 in the**  
4 **Chukut Kuk District has been filed pursuant to Article VIII of the**  
5 **Uniform Election Ordinance No. 03-86 of the Tohono O'Odham**  
6 **Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 of said Ordinance the Council has set the**  
9 **date of August 17, 1992 to meet for the sole purpose of hearing the**  
10 **contest; and**

11 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 of said Ordinance the Council has elected a**  
12 **Chairman of the Election Contest from the floor who is Robert A.**  
13 **Hershey; and**

14  
15 **WHEREAS, the Council deemed it prudent and necessary to establish rules of**  
16 **procedure for the Election Contest hearing for the purpose of**  
17 **maintaining order and discipline and to outline the duties and**  
18 **responsibilities of the Chairman of the Election Contest.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**  
21 **Council that it hereby adopts the attached Rules of Procedure for**  
22 **the Election Contest Hearing scheduled for August 17, 1992.**

24 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on**  
25 **the 10TH day of August, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present**  
26 **with a vote of 1,076.0 FOR; 194.0 AGAINST; 454.0 NOT VOTING; and**  
27 **02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(a) of**  
28 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
**Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
**Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,**  
**pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




