RESOLUTION NO. 92-325

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Law Enforcement Services Program under FY 1992 P. L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Nation has been informed of final funding for the Law Enforcement and Detention Services Program which reflects a decrease for FY 92; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did submit its FY 91 Final Financial Report which reflects unexpended funds; and

WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval reflecting FY 1992 Final allocation and FY 91 Carryover funds by the Law Enforcement and Detention Services Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the amendment to the Law Enforcement and Detention Services Program contract and requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to carryover unexpended



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman,
Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized
to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any
amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the
contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 10TH. day of AUGUST, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 1,475.0 FOR; 53.0 AGAINST; 196.0 NOT
VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






