5 *Backlog Elimination under an FY 1992 P. L. 93-638 contract*
6 *with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and*

8 **WHEREAS,** *the primary purpose of the Probate Backlog Elimination Program*
9 *is to assist Districts and individuals in the preparation of family*
10 *histories, inventories and to secure data which would constitute a*
11 *complete probate file for review and submittal to the*
12 *Administrative Law Judge; and*

14 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is desirous to continue*
15 *providing the Probate Backlog Elimination Program Services to*
16 *its tribal members in order to close out outstanding cases; and*

18 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Nation has been informed of funding for*
19 *the Probate Backlog Elimination Program for FY 92 in the*
20 *amount of \$15,000; and*

22 **WHEREAS,** *the Probate Backlog Elimination Program has submitted a budget*
23 *to reflect the FY 92 Allocation and Tentative Allocation for Fiscal*
24 *Year 1993 for review and approval.*

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative*
27 *Council that it does hereby authorize and request the Bureau of*
28 *Indian Affairs to extend Contract No. 1450CTH54T61017 with*



*the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman,
Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized
to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any
amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the
contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
Council.*

*The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 11TH day of AUGUST, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 1,724.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING;
and 04 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1
(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by
the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).*
