3 **WHEREAS,** *the Peace and Dignity Journeys 1992 transcontinental run was*  
4 *created to promote recognition of Indigenous Peoples. The run*  
5 *will pass through the Southwest in late August 1992; and*

6  
7 **WHEREAS,** *the run carries the desire to build a future of peaceful coexistence*  
8 *with the 4-colors of the world; Red, Yellow, White, and Black,*  
9 *and also promotes awareness of the sacredness and delicate*  
10 *balance of nature and the environment by the maintenance of*  
11 *cultural and spiritual values, and finally to promote physical*  
12 *fitness; and*

15 **WHEREAS,** *on May 02, 1992 the Peace and Dignity Journeys 1992 run began*  
16 *in Tok, Alaska and will descend south and arrive in Mexico City*  
17 *on October 12, 1992. Simultaneously the other half of the Peace*  
18 *and Dignity Journeys group started their journey north from the*  
19 *southern tip of Argentina and is also expected to arrive in Mexico*  
20 *City on October 12, 1992; and*

23 **WHEREAS,** *the Peace and Dignity Journeys is an open event to all people and*  
24 *welcomes the full participation of the Tohono O'odham Nation in*  
25 *this historic event; and*

27 **WHEREAS,** *the Peace and Dignity Journeys recognizes and respects the*  
28 *sovereign powers of the Tohono O'odham Nation as Indigenous*


*People and thereby requests the Nation's support and endorsement of the Peace and Dignity Journeys 1992; and*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does give its support and endorsement of the Peace and Dignity Journeys 1992 - transcontinental run.*

*The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 12TH. day of AUGUST, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,335.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 274.5 NOT VOTING; and 114.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).*
