

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Allocating \$17,500 from General Reserves for Emergency Assistance)**

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3 **WHEREAS, a housing request for an elder fire victim was forwarded by the**
4 **Baboquivari District to the Legislative Council; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislature is aware of a proposal from the Executive Branch**
6 **to establish an emergency relief fund for the Nation's members**
7 **experiencing crisis situations; and**

9 **WHEREAS, to date, said proposal has not been reviewed or approved by the**
10 **Legislative Council; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Council informed the Legislature that the**
12 **Topawa Community attempted to seek, without success, emer-**
13 **gency relief services from agencies outside the reservation; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation feels compassionate about the issues**
16 **and hardships affecting its members, particularly its elderly**
17 **members.**

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19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
20 **Council that it hereby allocates \$17,500.00 from the Nation's**
21 **General Reserve Fund for the purpose of providing emergency**
22 **housing assistance to Mrs. Dorothy Kirman of Topawa Village.**

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24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Baboquivari District will provide and be**
25 **accountable for a budget outlining the costs.**

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27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the funds be made available by August 28,**
28 **1992.**


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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 12TH day of AUGUST, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,336.5 FOR; 273.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 114.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




