LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 92-388

- WHEREAS, on September 23, 1992 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council continued the review of the Executive Office Budget; and
- WHEREAS, the budget presented did not include recommendation made by the Budget & Finance Committee, specifically:
  - a. Line item 060 "Professional Services" in the amount of \$41,000; the Committee recommended to (1) delete \$30,000 earmarked for legal assistance for border issues and (2) to omit the remaining \$21,000 earmarked to establish a Cultural Affairs Office pending a budget proposal for the use of these funds; and
- WHEREAS, furthermore, members of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recommended that the "Emergency Fund" line item (611), in the amount of \$100,000.00, be omitted from this budget and established in a separate account; and
- WHEREAS, the Presiding Officer requested a consensus from the Tohono
  O'odham Legislative Council on the above-stated recommendations;
  and
- WHEREAS, an objection was raised, and therefore a formal motion was requested.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative

  Council that it hereby amends the Executive Office Budget for FY
  1993 in the following manner:
