

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1993 Water Projects Office Funding Request
10/01/92 to 03/31/93)

RESOLUTION NO. 92-392

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3 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated the Water Projects*
4 *Office to provide administrative services under a P. L. 93-638*
5 *contract with the Bureau of Reclamation for the development of*
6 *farm projects in the San Xavier and Schuk Toak Districts under*
7 *contracts No. 8-CS-30-04830 and No. 8-CS-32-00380 respectively;*
8 *and*

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11 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council by means of*
12 *Resolutions 92-269, 92-270, and 92-271 approved budgets for FY*
13 *1993 and scopes of work to be submitted to the Bureau of*
14 *Reclamation for either extensions of the above mentioned*
15 *contracts or for negotiation of a new P. L. 93-638 Contract; and*

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18 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council provided interim*
19 *funding for FY 1992 from FY 1992 General Revenues and the*
20 *SAWRSA Trust Fund to maintain operation of the Water Projects*
21 *Office; and*

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23 **WHEREAS,** *the Water Projects Office is in the process of submitting an*
24 *application including a budget and scope of work to the Bureau*
25 *of Reclamation to complete designs for the San Xavier*
26 *Cooperative Farm Rehabilitation and the Schuk Toak Farm; and*

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28 **WHEREAS,** *under P. L. 93-638, the Bureau of Reclamation will be required*

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to respond to the Water Projects Office's proposal within a specific time frame; and

WHEREAS, *the Water Projects Office finds that it must submit a budget to cover staff salaries, support costs and subcontracts to be approved in the interim while the proposal is negotiated with the Bureau of Reclamation; and*

WHEREAS, *the Water Projects Office is requesting from the Tohono O'Odham Nation interim funding in the amount of \$358,956.00 enabling the continued operation of the Water Projects Office until a new contract is provided to the Tohono O'Odham Nation. Reimbursement for those contracts attributable to the contracts will be sought through the Bureau of Reclamation once the contract is executed.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the funding request and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED *that funds in the amount of \$358,956.00 are hereby approved from the SAWRSA Trust Fund to cover the period from October 1, 1992 through March 31, 1993.*

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED *that reimbursement for such funds advanced by*

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the Tohono O'Odham Nation that are determined to be allocable
to the contracts will be sought from the Bureau of Reclamation.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 24TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,457.0 FOR; 120.5 AGAINST; 146.5 NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






