

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1993 Water Resources Study Recontract Proposal)**

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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Water**
4 **Resources Study Program under FY 1992 P. L. 93-638 contract**
5 **with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

7 **WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the**
8 **Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and**

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10 **WHEREAS, 25 CFR 271.20 of the Code of Federal Regulations requires that**
11 **all proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the**
12 **Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council for approval at least 120**
13 **days prior to the current contract termination; and**

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15 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to recontract for**
16 **provision of services during FY 1993; and**

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18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and**
19 **approved the FY 1993 Water Resources Study Program proposal**
20 **and budget.**

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22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
23 **Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian**
24 **Affairs to recontract with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under**
25 **P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the provision of**
26 **services titled: Water Resources Study.**

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28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the recontract shall**

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commence on October 01, 1992 through September 30, 1993.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
*the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program
in the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no
executed contract extension has been approved by the Bureau of
Indian Affairs, unless the agency authorizes and approves pre-
award costs consistent with the Indian Self-Determination Act, as
amended and relevant contract regulations.*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
*the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman,
Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized
to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any
amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the
contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
Council.*

*The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 28TH day of September, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 1,325.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 399.0 NOT
VOTING; and 11 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).*

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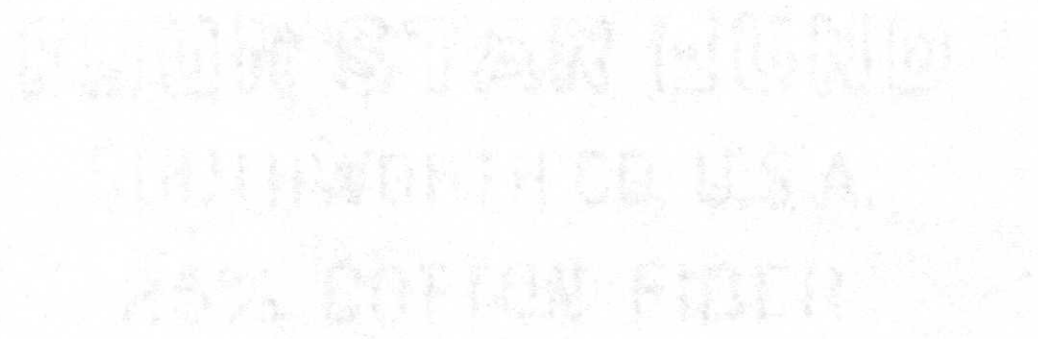
