

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Extension of Fringe Benefits to the
Employees of Papago Bingo)

RESOLUTION NO. 92-428

WHEREAS, the employees of Papago Bingo have been determined to be employees of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation provides employees with a fringe benefit package which includes the following components:

- a. Medical Insurance**
- b. Dental Insurance**
- c. Death & Dismemberment Insurance**
- d. Long Term Disability**
- e. Term Life Insurance**
- f. Retirement; and**

WHEREAS, the cost of such fringe benefits are to be borne as an expense of Papago Bingo; and

WHEREAS, the FY-93 Papago Bingo operating budget includes a line item for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, Legislative Council Resolution No. 91-195 directed the Personnel Department and the Executive to gather data on this matter; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Office recommends this action to the Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation authorizes the extension of the Nation's

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** *that the cost of such fringe benefit program shall*
7 *be treated as an expense of Papago Bingo.*

9 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** *that the Executive Branch acting by and through*
10 *the Personnel Department and the Nation's Insurance Manager*
11 *take steps to extend such coverages as soon as possible while at*
12 *the same time preserving and protecting the Nation's current*
13 *Fringe Benefit Program.*

15 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** *that the Nation's Chairman is authorized to*
16 *execute contracts, with prior legal review, to effectuate this*
17 *extension of fringe benefits, provided all such contracts are*
18 *consistent with the terms of this resolution.*

27 *approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)*
28 *on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.*
984).
