4 **WHEREAS,** *the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation pursuant*
5 *to Resolution 92-389 abolished the Nation's O'Odham in Mexico*
6 *Program and did not therefore appropriate funds for this program*
7 *in Resolution 92-390, which adopted the FY-'93 Executive Branch*
8 *operating budget; and*

9
10 **WHEREAS,** *the Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Nation returned*
11 *Resolution 92-389 with a memorandum disapproving the*
12 *resolution as provided for in the Nation's Constitution, which*
13 *required a further vote to make said Resolution effective and to*
14 *overcome the disapproval; and*

17 **WHEREAS,** *the Nation's O'Odham in Mexico Office was closed and staff laid-*
18 *off effective September 30, 1992 due to the lack of operating*
19 *funds for the current fiscal year which began October 1, 1992;*
20 *and*

21
22 **WHEREAS,** *the Legislative Council reconsidered Resolution 92-389 on October*
23 *12, 1992 and failed to achieve the necessary two-thirds majority*
24 *to override the disapproval of the Nation's Chairman; and*

26 **WHEREAS,** *the combined effect of the above noted series of Legislative*
27 *Council and Executive actions is to leave the O'Odham in Mexico*
28 *Program in existence within the Nation's Executive Branch but*

3 *without funding to provide services, employ staff or to conduct*

5 *any actions; and*

7 **WHEREAS,** *members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation residing in Mexico*
8 *continue to require services from the Nation, such as*
9 *transportation to the IHS Sells Clinic for medical treatment and*
10 *other services provided by the Nation's several programs; and*

11
12 **WHEREAS,** *the Chairman of the Nation recommends that the O'Odham in*
13 *Mexico Program be funded in the amount of \$107,124.*

14
15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative*
16 *Council that it approves the FY 1993 O'Odham in Mexico*
17 *Program budget submitted by the Executive Branch. It is*
18 *recognized that payroll taxes for the Program employees, in the*
19 *amount of 10% of budgeted salaries, are included in this budget.*
20 *An additional amount, equal to 16% of budgeted salaries, is*
21 *budgeted for Employee Benefits for the employees of all three*
22 *Branches of the Tohono O'Odham Nation and this is made a part*
23 *of the Executive Branch budget.*

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** *that funds in the amount of \$107,124.00 are*
28 *appropriated and authorized to be expended from the sources of*



Executive Office before the end of the first quarter of FY 1993.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 13TH day of OCTOBER, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 868.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 358.0 NOT VOTING;
and 498.0 [15] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




