

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Designating Task Force to Develop Plan of Funding Support to
the Districts of the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 92-440

WHEREAS, some of the eleven Districts of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are
experiencing financial difficulties and shortages of funds with
which to provide District functions, operations and services to the
O'Odham of the various Districts; and

WHEREAS, the District Chairmen of the Tohono O'Odham Nation have met
and considered this critical situation; and

WHEREAS, as a proposed solution to this situation, the District Chairmen
through a joint Resolution presented a request to the Tohono
O'odham Legislative Council to allocate and disburse the sum of
\$1,000,000 to each District; and

WHEREAS, the leadership of the eleven Districts have requested that these
funds be allocated from P.L. 97-408 funds, commonly known as
the "Land Judgement Funds"; and

WHEREAS, this request was discussed at length and in detail at the November
1992 General Session of the Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, there was general agreement that concrete and accurate
information is needed to develop and implement a plan of funding
support for the Nation's Districts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby designates a Task Force whose purpose shall be to research and review pertinent information to develop a plan of funding support to the Districts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force will be comprised of the Legislative Budget & Finance Committee; the Executive Office; the Accounting Department; and the District Chairmen's Association, all of whom shall work jointly on this issue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force may also call upon whoever else they feel could provide necessary and relevant information to work with the Task Force.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Task Force will present their findings on this issue to the January 1993 General Session of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 16TH. day of NOVEMBER, 1992 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 08 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a), (b) & (d) (2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






