WHEREAS, items not listed on the running agenda were requested for Council consideration.



- 5. Baboquivari District Resolution on their District Chairman**

The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4TH. day of JANUARY, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,660.5 FOR; 63.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 01 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
