3 **WHEREAS, a report on Papago Bingo and an update on the Strategic Plan**
4 **were included on the Legislative Council's agenda for January 11,**
5 **1993; and**

6 **WHEREAS, it was anticipated that part of the discussion would include legal**

9 **WHEREAS, by Legislative Order No. 93-025, the Legislature was authorized to**
10 **proceed in closed session and to restrict attendance to those**
11 **individuals identified in the Strategic Plan as well as the San**
12 **Xavier District Vice Chairman; and**

14 **WHEREAS, a recommendation was made to amend the Order to also allow the**
15 **Nation's Vice Chairman to remain in this closed session.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
18 **Council that it hereby amends Legislative Order No. 93-025 to allow**
19 **the Nation's Vice Chairman to remain in this closed session to**
20 **address the report on Papago Bingo and the update on the Strategic**
21 **Plan.**

24 **the 11th day of January, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum was present**
25 **with a vote of 1,724.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 03**
26 **ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of**
27 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**
